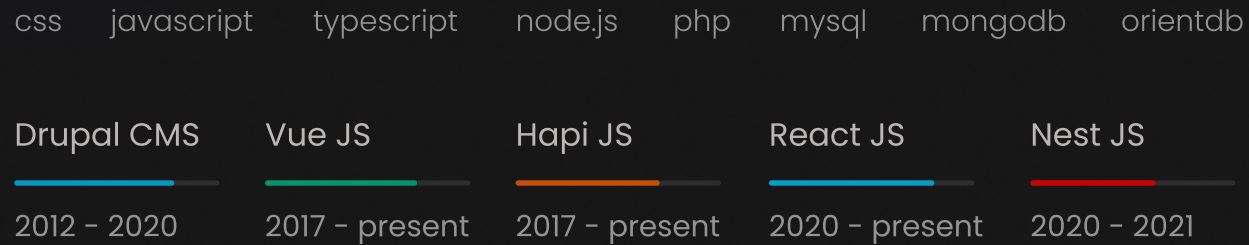

As a junior developer, I assisted my seniors on their Drupal projects, specifically for responsive CSS. Over time, I became familiar with Drupal and was soon employed as a developer. By 2015, I had earned the role of senior developer and began mentoring fellow developers.</p>

The cloud system allows Beauty Diary's headquarters to manage all locally-hosted POS systems from their showrooms.
